PALE (WHITE, GOLD & BLONDE)

Hophead, Dark Star Brewery £3.20
Our house ale and favourite session beer. Packed with biscuity malt and citrusy cascade hops. (East Sussex, UK) 3.8% ABV

Camden Hells Lager £3.80
Very clean drinking helles (Munich) style lager. Light and refreshing. (London, UK) 4.8% ABV **(v)**

Bitburger Premium Pils £3.80
Germany's No.1 draught beer for good reason. A hoppy pilsner that is dry and full-bodied. (Rheinland, Germany) 5% ABV

Chimay White (Tripel) £3.50
Banana bread up the nose and honey and lemon in the mouth. A light character with fine carbonation. (Hainaut Province, Belgium) 8% ABV **(v)**

Camden Pale Ale £3.80
Extremely clean tasting keg ale with orange and other delicate American hop flavours. (London, UK) 4.8% ABV **(v)**

AMBER, BROWN & RED

Brooklyn Lager £4.80
Viennese style lager containing caramel malt. With roots in Prohibition-era New York; a modern day classic. (New York, USA) 5.2% ABV **(v)**

Westmalle Dubbel £3.50
Richly layered, deeply malty brew deserving of its famous chalice glass. Apples, plums and rich caramel. (Malle, Belgium) 7% ABV **(v)**

Rodenbach, Palm Brewery £3
Refreshing, oak-aged 'sour red'. A sweet, cherry-like taste with a dry, sour finish. (Roeselare, Belgium) 5.2% ABV **(v)**

BLACK

PALE (WHITE, GOLD & BLONDE)

1 **Früh Kölsch** £4
Uncomplicated lager designed to be easy drinking. Faintly fruity, crisp and not as hoppy as pilsner lagers. (Köln, Germany) 4.8% ABV 500ml

2 **Schiehallion**, Harviestoun Brewery £4
Crisp, cask-conditioned pilsner style lager from Scotland. Winner of countless awards. (Clackmannanshire, UK) 4.8% ABV 500ml

3 **Kernel IPA** £4.50
Brewed in deepest Bermondsey on a tiny scale. The hops change, but always expect a fruit salad. (London, UK) 7–8% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

4 **Kernel Pale Ale** £5
An American style pale ale. Evin often uses different US and Kiwi hops so the pale ale we stock will vary. (London, UK) 5–6% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

5 **Otley O-Garden** £4
A micro-brewed version of the ubiquitous wheat beer Hoegaarden. Flavoured with cloves, coriander and citrus. (Pontypridd, UK) 4.8% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

6 **Golden Valley**, Breconshire Brewery £4
Thirst quenching blonde made with 'Progress', a soft English hop. Laden with apricot, lemon and floral flavours. (Powys, UK) 4.2% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

7 **Otley O8** £4.50
Full-bodied, pineapple barley wine, cinnamon spiced aroma and well disguised alcohol content. (Pontypridd, UK) 8% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

8 **Sierra Nevada Pale Ale** £4.50
One of the world's most renowned pale ales. Lemony smell and spicy flavours come from cascade hops. (California, USA) 5.6% ABV 350ml **(v) (bc)**

AMBER, BROWN & RED

9 **Kwak**, Bosteels Brewery £4
The strong amber ale is notable for more than just its tricky test tube glass. Full-bodied and alluring. (Buggenhout, Belgium) 8.9% ABV 330ml

10 **Harveys Blue Label** £3.50
A bottled version of Harvey's national favourite Sussex Best Bitter. (West Sussex, UK) 3.6% ABV 500ml

11 **Orval** £4.50
The King of Trappist Beers? A complex fermentation leads to a sophisticated taste with a long dry finish. (Gaume, Belgium) 6.2% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

12 **Molenbier**, De Molen Brewery £6
'Mill workers' must be treated well in the Netherlands with this orangey barley wine. (Bodegraven, Netherlands) 9.2% ABV 330ml

13 **La Trappe Dubbel** £4.50
From the only Trappist brewery in the Netherlands. It leaves a lasting experience of rich 'red' flavours. (Pilburg, Netherlands) 8.4% ABV 330ml **(v)**

14 **Brew Dog Hardcore IPA** £4.50
Massive grapefruity, piney, sweet-fruit start and a slap-in-the-face bitter finish. Hardcore indeed. (Aberdeenshire, UK) 9.2% ABV 330ml **(v)**

15 **Great Divide Titan IPA** £4.50
Americans pack IPAs full of their fruity hops. Expect lemon, honey and pine to be assertive flavours. (Colorado, USA) 6.8% ABV 355ml **(v)**

16 **Rochefort 10** £6
Traditional, complicated Trappist quadrupel. An aroma of figs and a sensation of honey in the mouth. (Rochefort, Belgium) 11.3% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

17 **Schneider Weisse Original** £4.50
The world's best wheat beer. Highly carbonated, full bodied, spicy, and rich. (Kelheim, Germany) 5.4% ABV 500ml **(bc)**

18 **Duchess de Bourgogne**, Verhaegen Brewery £4
A smooth, sour, traditional Flemish red ale, matured in oak for 8–18 months. Flavours from cherry to chocolate. (West-Vlaanderen, Belgium) 6.2% ABV 250ml

19 **Old Foghorn**, Anchor Brewery £5
Sweet upfront and spicy in the back. A well-balanced 'beer' to initiate newcomers to 'barley wine'. (California, USA) 8.8% ABV 355ml **(v)**

BLACK

20 **Gorlovka Imperial Stout**, Acorn Brewery £4.50
Gorlovka (Ukraine) is twinned with Barnsley. At 6%, it's an approachable Imperial Stout. (Barnsley, UK) 6% ABV 500ml

21 **Anchor Porter** £4
A thick, creamy head. Intense nutty caramel, liquorice and leathery rich flavour with a sweetish finish. (California, USA) 5.6% ABV 355ml **(v)**

22 **Kernel Export Stout** £4.50
Based on an 1890 recipe from Truman Brewery. Dark black, oily, dried fruit, herbal and lingering espresso. (London, UK) 7.8% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

23 **Brodie's Taylored London Porter** £4.50
Alex & Rach helped brew this Superior London Porter. Lagered for three weeks, a smooth and rich beast. (London, UK) 8–9% ABV 500ml **(bc)**

24 **Brooklyn Black Chocolate Stout** £5
Strong Imperial stout with complicated fruit and chocolate malt character. (New York, USA) 10.1% ABV 355ml **(v)**

25 **Left Hand Milk Stout** £4
Milk sugar in your stout is like cream in your coffee. Delicious full-bodied sweet stout. (Colorado, USA) 5.2% ABV 355ml

26 **Kernel Porter** £4.50
A dry and roasty porter based on a Victorian recipe from the Courage Brewery. (London, UK) 5–6% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

27 **O'Hanlon's Port Stout** £4
The Irish tradition for a morning after 'corpse-reviver' – a splash of Port in your stout. (Exeter, UK) 4.8% ABV 500ml

28 **Chocolate Marble**, Marble Brewery £4.50
Softly carbonated porter with flavours of cocoa and coffee with an earthy bitterness and dry finish. (Manchester, UK) 5.5% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

ODDITIES

29 **Ginger Marble**, Marble Brewery £4.50
Real ginger creates a herbal burn and tang that lasts for ages. You may be surprised how moreish it is. (Manchester, UK) 4.5% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

30 **Ola Dubh Special Reserve**, Harviestoun Brewery £12
The best whisky cask beer. Incredibly smooth with lots of peat, vanilla and wood (40 year old casks). (Clackmannanshire, UK) 8% ABV 330ml

31 **Fraoch Heather Ale**, Williams Bros Brewery £4.50
No hops, just heather, tastes of honey and flowers. It may be the oldest beer style in the world. (Alloa, UK) 5% ABV 500ml

32 **Kernel Coffee IPA**, Collaborative brew with Square Mile Coffee Roasters. £4.50
Peach and orange tones match the subtly of Ethiopia's Suke Quto Sidamo coffee. (London, UK) 6.5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

33 **Timmerman's Geuze** £5
More like a medium dry cider or wine, the sour blend of aged lambic beers is well balanced by added sugars. (Itterbeek, Belgium) 5% ABV 375ml

FRUIT

34 **Fruli**, Huyghe Brewery £4
Pure strawberry juice blended into a zesty wheat beer. One for those with a sweet tooth. (Melle, Belgium) 4.1% ABV 250ml

35 **Boon Kriek** £5
Matured in oak casks for two years with 200 grams of cherries per litre. Being sweet, it's a good bottle to share. (Lambeeck, Belgium) 5% ABV 375ml

36 **Mongozo Mango** £4.50
This 'Exotic Beer' is a light, slightly spicy malt beer blended with fresh Fairtrade mangoes. (Melle, Belgium) 3.6% ABV 330ml

37 **Roisin**, Williams Bros Brewery £5
Pronounced 'Rosheen'. Flavoured with Tayberry, a raspberry and blackberry hybrid grown in the Tay Valley. (Alloa, UK) 4.2% ABV 500ml

38 **Brodie's Passion** £4.50
Tonnes of fresh passion fruit packs a pungent punch. A crisp zip makes this a moreish treat. (London, UK) 3.8% ABV 500ml **(bc)**

39 **Mongozo Pilsner**, Huyghe Brewery £3.50
Light, bitter hoppy taste. Launched in 2010 as the world's first gluten free pilsner. (Melle, Belgium) 5% ABV 330ml **(v) (gf)**

40 **Veltins Alkoholfrei** £3
The best alcohol-free beer we could find. (Meschede–Grevenstein, Germany) 0.5% ABV 330ml **(af)**
