1 <b>Ceilidh</b> , William Bros Brewery Bottled lager to beat any of the big brands. Good bite, hop character and biscuit. (Alloa, UK) 4-7% ABV 330ml <b>(v)</b>	£4
2 <b>Schiehallion</b> , Harviestoun Brewery Crisp, cask-conditioned pilsner style lager from Scotland. Winner of countless awards. (Clackmannanshire, UK) 4-8% ABV 500ml	£5
3 <b>Orange Wheat Beer</b> , Green Jack Brewery Orange peel and citra hops for gentle marmalade flavours and relatively subtle sweetness. (Lowestoft, UK) 4-2% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
4 <b>Kernel Pale Ale</b> The new-world hops used vary week by week but the results are always popular (London, UK) 5–6% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
5 <b>Little Creatures Pale Ale</b> A new-world classic. Galaxy and cascade hops give it a great grapefruit bite. (Fremantle, Australia) 5-2% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£4
6 <b>Saison Du Pont</b> Harvest refreshment. Tart, crisp, dry, refreshing and known globally as <i>the saison</i> . (Wallonia, Belgium) 6-5% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
7 <b>Otley O8</b> Full-bodied, pineapplepy golden ale. Cinnamon spiced aroma and well disguised alcohol content. (Pontypridd, UK) 8% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5-50
8 <b>De Ranke XX Bitter</b> Unique (extra extra) hoppy bitter from Belgium. Brewers gold and hallertau hops to the fore. (Dottignies/Dottenijs, Belgium) 6-2% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
9 <b>La Chouffe</b> Strong golden ale to rival Duvel. Coriander spiced, lightly hopped and zesty. (Achouffe, Belgium) 8% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5-50
10 <b>Estrella Damm Inedit</b> Ferran Adrià, the el Bulli team & Estrella have nailed the aim of making a food beer to share. Moreish. (Barcelona, Spain) 4-8% ABV 750ml <b>(v) (bc) (s)</b>	£12
11 <b>Oakham Citra</b> Exotic grapefruit and lychee aroma. First UK brewery to use the hop de jour in a fresh pale ale. (Peterborough, UK) 4-6% ABV 500ml	£4-50
12 <b>Kernel IPA</b> Brewed in deepest Bermondsey on a tiny scale. The hops change, but always expect a fruit salad. (London, UK) 7–8% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
13 <b>Punk IPA</b> , BrewDog Brewery In a can!? Resinous, warming, tropical and complex with a firm bitter finish. (Aberdeenshire, UK) 6% ABV 330ml <b>(v)</b>	£4
14 <b>Raging Bitch Belgian IPA</b> , Flying Dog Brewery Spicy toast and banana from Belgian yeast. Big bitter grapefruit hit from amarillo hops. A belter. (Maryland, USA) 8-3% ABV 355ml <b>(v)</b>	£5-50
15 <b>Hoxton Special IPA</b> , Brodie’s Brewery Pale, passion fruit and piney West Coast style IPA. A new house-favourite from our neighbours in Leyton. (London, UK) 6-6% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5

16 <b>Honkers Ale</b> , Goose Island Brewery Best bitter with a bready malt flavour and gentle fruity hops; exceptionally easy drinking. (Chicago, USA) 4-2% ABV 355ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£4
17 <b>Kwak</b> , Bosteels Brewery The strong amber ale is notable for more than just its tricky test tube glass. Full-bodied and alluring. (Buggenhout, Belgium) 8-9% ABV 330ml	£4-50
18 <b>Seven</b> , Bristol Beer Factory Traditional best bitter. Toffee malt flavours, toast and caramel. Smooth hop bitterness and aroma. Classic. (Bristol, UK) 4-5% ABV 500ml	£4
19 <b>La Trappe Quadrupel</b> A robust malty beast. Complicated aroma and taste; peach, dried fruits and a long rum-like finish. (Pilburg, Netherlands) 10% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£6
20 <b>Southville Hop</b> , Bristol Beer Factory Grapefruit, pineapple, passion fruit and jaffa cakes from American hops. Great English/American IPA. (Bristol, UK) 6-5% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
21 <b>Hackney Red IPA</b> , Brodie’s Brewery Amarillo and citra hops make a tangy marmalade. Cara red malt for colour and more bitterness. Yum. (London, UK) 6-1% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
22 <b>Gone Fishing ESB</b> , Green Jack Brewery Softly carbonated, nutty ESB. Caramel, red fruit and subtle flowers. Discreetly bitter. (Lowestoft, UK) 5-5% ABV 750ml <b>(v) (bc) (s)</b>	£9
23 <b>Ripper</b> , Green Jack Brewery Summer fruit, herb and toffee flavoured barley wine. A great sharing bottle. Peachy. (Lowestoft, UK) 8-5% ABV 750ml <b>(v) (bc) (s)</b>	£12

24 <b>Dalston Black IPA</b> , Brodie’s Brewery Galaxy hops impart mandarin and mango flavours. Carafa malts build a roasty charcoal backbone. (London, UK) 7% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
25 <b>Hercule Stout</b> , Ellezelloise Brewery Named after Ellezelles’, and Belgium’s most famous detective, Hercule Poirot. Sprucey Belgian ‘Imperial Stout’. (Ellezelles, Belgium) 8-4% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5-50
26 <b>Bristol Milk Stout</b> , Bristol Beer Factory Milk sugar in your stout is like cream in your coffee. Delicious sweet stout. (Bristol, UK) 4-5% ABV 500ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£4-50
27 <b>Kernel Export Stout: 1890 London</b> ‘Supreme Champion’ at the International Beer Challenge 2011. The Truman recipe is a wintry house favourite. (London, UK) 7-5% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
28 <b>Kernel Export Porter</b> Fusion beer: American hops with a strong English porter recipe. Grass, herbs, chocolate and orange. (London, UK) 5–6% ABV 330ml <b>(v) (bc)</b>	£5
29 <b>Jacobite Ale</b> , Traquair Brewery Brewed in the oldest inhabited house in Scotland. A coriander-spiced and oak-aged Scotch ale, made in memory of the 1745 Jacobite rebellion. (Peeblesshire, UK) 8% ABV 330ml <b>(v)</b>	£5

30 <b>Rauchbier Märzen</b> , Aecht Schlenkerla The world’s most famous (beech) smoked beer from Bamberg, Bavaria’s medieval UNESCO world heritage site. (Bamberg, Germany) 5-4% ABV 500ml <b>(v)</b>	£6
31 <b>Innis &amp; Gunn Original</b> , Innis & Gunn Brewery The first brewery to create a whisky-cask beer. Honey coloured. Smooth vanilla, toffee and oak from a 77 day ageing process. (Edinburgh, UK) 6-6% ABV 330ml <b>(v)</b>	£4-50
32 <b>Fraoch Heather Ale</b> , Williams Bros Brewery No hops, just heather, tastes of honey and flowers. It may be the oldest beer style in the world. (Alloa, UK) 5% ABV 500ml	£5
33 <b>Mariage Parfait Oude Geuze</b> , Boon Brewery Traditional, chewy, appley sour beer. The pinnacle of Boon’s lambic blending craft. (Lembeek, Belgium) 8% ABV 375ml <b>(v) (bc) (s)</b>	£7
34 <b>Orchard Pig Medium Cider</b> It’s not beer. In addition to our still ciders in flagons, this lightly sparkling, bottled cider tastes as fresh as they come. (Glastonbury, UK) 6-5% ABV 500ml <b>(v)</b>	£4-50

35 <b>Kasteel Rouge</b> Cherry Tunes without the menthol. Kasteel’s brown ale, matured for 6 months with sour cherries. (Ingelmunster, Belgium) 8% ABV 330ml	£5
36 <b>Echt Kriekenbier</b> , Verhaeghe Brewery A slightly funky, sour and woody cherry beer from Flanders. Reminiscent of a good cherry tart. (West-Vlaanderen, Belgium) 6-8% ABV 330ml <b>(v)</b>	£5
37 <b>Mongozo Mango</b> , Huyghe Brewery This ‘exotic beer’ is a light, slightly spicy malt beer blended with fresh Fairtrade mangoes. (Melle, Belgium) 3-6% ABV 330ml	£4-50
38 <b>Lindemans Cassis</b> Belgians have used blackcurrants for centuries to make crisp, sweet/sour lambic fruit beers. (St Pieters Leeuw-Vlezenbeek, Belgium) 3-5% ABV 250ml <b>(v)</b>	£4

<b>Thornbridge Jaipur IPA</b> This beer is best in a keg. Huge orange and grapefruit freshness. Pretty bitter. (Bakewell, UK) 5-9% ABV <b>(v)</b>	£4-50
