PALE (WHITE, GOLD & BLONDE)

Hophead, Dark Star Brewery £3-40
Our house ale and favourite session beer. Packed with biscuity malt and citrusy cascade hops. (East Sussex, UK) 3-8% ABV

Camden Hells Lager £3-80
Very clean drinking helles (Munich) style lager. Light and refreshing. (London, UK) 4-8% ABV **(v)**

Thornbridge Jaipur IPA £4-50
New in a Keg and it's best in a keg! Huge orange and grapefruit freshness. (Bakewell, UK) 5-9% ABV **(v)**

Chimay White (Tripel) £3-80
Banana bread up the nose and honey and lemon in the mouth. A light character with fine carbonation. (Hainaut Province, Belgium) 8% ABV **(v)**

Camden Pale Ale £3-80
Extremely clean tasting keg ale with orange and other delicate American hop flavours. (London, UK) 4-8% ABV **(v)**

AMBER, BROWN & RED

Brooklyn Lager £4-80
Viennese style lager containing caramel malt. With roots in Prohibition-era New York; a modern day classic. (New York, USA) 5-2% ABV **(v)**

St Bernadus Pater £3-50
The jovial monk looks justly proud of this easy drinking, silky dubbel. Ruby red, dark fruits and banana bread. (Watou, Belgium) 6-5% ABV **(v)**

FRUIT

Fruili, Huyghe Brewery £3
Pure strawberry juice blended into a zesty wheat beer. A treat for those with a sweet tooth. (Melle, Belgium) 4-1% ABV

PALE (WHITE, GOLD & BLONDE)

1 **Ceilidh**, William Bros Brewery £4
Bottled lager to beat any of the big brands. Good bite, hop character and biscuit. (Alloa, UK) 4-7% ABV 330ml **(v)**

2 **Stiegl Goldbräu** £4
Austria's biggest selling beer for good reason. As clean, refreshing and uncomplicated as Corona. (Salzburg, Austria) 4-9% ABV 330ml

3 **Schiehallion**, Harviestoun Brewery £5
Crisp, cask-conditioned pilsner style lager from Scotland. Winner of countless awards. (Clackmannanshire, UK) 4-8% ABV 500ml

4 **Kernel IPA** £5
Brewed in deepest Bermondsey on a tiny scale. The hops change, but always expect a fruit salad. (London, UK) 7-8% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

5 **Raging Bitch Belgian IPA**, Flying Dog Brewery £5-50
Spicy toast and banana from Belgian yeast. Big bitter grapefruit hit from Amarillo hops. A belter. (Maryland, USA) 8-3% ABV 355ml **(v)**

6 **Kernel Pale Ale** £5
An American style pale ale. Evin often uses different US and Kiwi hops so the pale ale we stock will vary. (London, UK) 5-6% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

7 **Doggy Style Pale Ale**, Flying Dog Brewery £5
Cascade hops. Crisp lemony almost amber pale ale. Caramel flavour and colour from crystal malts. (Maryland, USA) 8-5% ABV 355ml **(v)**

8 **Otley O-Garden** £4-50
A micro-brewed version of the ubiquitous wheat beer Hoegaarden. Flavoured with cloves, coriander and citrus. (Pontypridd, UK) 4-8% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

9 **Blanche de Bruxelles**, Brasserie Lefebvre £5
Light, refreshing wheat beer. More coriander and bitter orange to the clove/lemon of Hoegaarden. (Rebecq-Quenast, Belgium) 4-5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

10 **Otley O8** £5-50
Full-bodied, pineappley barley wine, cinnamon spiced aroma and well disguised alcohol content. (Pontypridd, UK) 8% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

11 **De Ranke XX Bitter** £5
Unique (extra extra) hoppy bitter from Belgium. Brewers Gold and Hallertau hops to the fore. (Dottignies/Dottenijs, Belgium) 6-2% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

12 **La Chouffe** £5-50
Strong golden ale to rival Duvel. Coriander spiced, lightly hopped and zesty. (Achouffe, Belgium) 8% ABV **(v) (bc)**

13 **Duvel**, Moorgat Brewery £5
Pronounced *doo-vel*. Champagne fizz and elegance. Massive creamy head, dry finish. World classic. (Brendonk-Puurs, Belgium) 8-5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

14 **Oakham Citra** £4-50
Exotic grapefruit and lychee aroma. First UK brewery to use the hop de jour in a fresh pale ale. (Peterborough, UK) 4-6% ABV 500ml

AMBER, BROWN & RED

15 **St Bernadus Tripel** £5
A tripel to rival Chimay White on draught. Banana, herb and honey aroma; spice, flowers and citrus in the flavour. (Watou, Belgium) 8% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

16 **Kwak**, Bosteels Brewery £4-50
The strong amber ale is notable for more than just its tricky test tube glass. Full-bodied and alluring. (Buggenhout, Belgium) 8-9% ABV 330ml

17 **Bristol Beer Factory No. 7** £4
Traditional Best Bitter. Toffee malt flavours, toast and caramel. Smooth hop bitterness and aroma. Classic. (Bristol, UK) 4-5% ABV 500ml

18 **Orval** £5
The King of Trappist Beers? A complex fermentation leads to a sophisticated taste with a long dry finish. (Gaume, Belgium) 6-2% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

19 **La Trappe Dubbel** £5
From the only Trappist brewery in the Netherlands. It leaves a lasting experience of rich 'red' flavours. (Pilburg, Netherlands) 8-4% ABV 330ml **(v)**

20 **Southville Hop**, Bristol Beer Factory £5
Grapefruit, pineapple, passion fruit and jaffa cakes from American hops. Great English/American IPA. (Bristol, UK) 6-5% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

21 **Rochefort 10** £6
Traditional, complicated Trappist quadrupel. An aroma of figs and a sensation of honey in the mouth. (Rochefort, Belgium) 11-3% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

22 **Schneider Weisse Original** £5
The world's best wheat beer. Highly carbonated, full bodied, spicy, and rich. (Kelheim, Germany) 5-4% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

23 **Schneider Weisse Unser Aventinus** £6-50
Big, silky, deeply charachetered doppelbock that's been tantilising since 1907. Sip this full bodied monster. (Kelheim, Germany) 8-2% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

24 **Duchess de Bourgogne**, Verhaegen Brewery £4-50
A smooth, sour, traditional Flemish red ale, matured in oak for 8-18 months. Flavours from cherry to chocolate. (West-Vlaanderen, Belgium) 6-2% ABV 330ml

25 **Green Jack Ripper** £12
Summer fruit, herb and toffee flavoured barley wine. A great sharing bottle. Peachy. (Lowestoft, UK) 8-5% ABV 750ml **(v) (bc)**

BLACK

26 **Meantime Porter** £10
Milk chocolate, coffee, leather, roasted malt and dark fruit. Easy to drink porter that's great to share. (London, UK) 6-5% ABV 750ml **(v)**

27 **Anchor Porter** £4
A thick, creamy head. Intense nutty caramel, liquorice and leathery rich flavour with a sweetish finish. (California, USA) 5-6% ABV 355ml **(v)**

28 **Brodie's Taylored London Porter** £5
Alex & Rach helped brew this Superior London Porter. Lagered for three weeks, a smooth and rich beast. (London, UK) 8-9% ABV 500ml **(bc)**

29 **Kernel India Export Porter** £5
Fusion beer: American hops with a strong English porter recipe. Grassy, herbal, chocolate and orange. (London, UK) 5-6% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**

30 **Chocolate Marble**, Marble Brewery £5
Softly carbonated porter with flavours of cocoa and coffee with an earthy bitterness and dry finish. (Manchester, UK) 5-5% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

ODDITIES

31 **Ginger Marble 6**, Marble Brewery £5
Real ginger creates a herbal burn and tang that lasts for ages. You may be surprised how moreish it is. (Manchester, UK) 6% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**

32 **Ola Dubh Special Reserve**, Harviestoun Brewery £12
The best whisky cask beer. Incredibly smooth with lots of peat, vanilla and wood (40 year old casks). (Clackmannanshire, UK) 8% ABV 330ml

33 **Fraoch Heather Ale**, Williams Bros Brewery £5
No hops, just heather, tastes of honey and flowers. It may be the oldest beer style in the world. (Alloa, UK) 5% ABV 500ml

34 **Lindemans Faro** £4
Lambics are more like tart ciders or wines. The tartness of Faro Lambics are balanced by added sugars. (St Pieters Leeuw-Vlezenbeek, Belgium) 4-75% ABV 250ml **(v)**

FRUIT

35 **Kasteel Rouge** £5
Cherry tunes without the menthol. Kasteel's brown ale matured for 6 months with sour cherries. (Ingelmunster, Belgium) 8% ABV 330ml

36 **Brussels Kriek**, Van Steenberge Brewery £4
Ruby red colour. Cherry drops from your childhood with raspberry and strawberry to boot. (Ertvelde, Belgium) 3-5% ABV 250ml

37 **Mongozo Mango** £4-50
This 'Exotic Beer' is a light, slightly spicy malt beer blended with fresh Fairtrade mangoes. (Melle, Belgium) 3-6% ABV 330ml

38 **Lindemans Cassis** £4
Belgians have used blackcurrants for centuries to make crisp, sweet/sour lambic fruit beers. (St Pieters Leeuw-Vlezenbeek, Belgium) 3-5% ABV 250ml **(v)**

'FREE FROM' ...

39 **Mongozo Pilsner**, Huyghe Brewery £3-50
Light, bitter hoppy taste. Launched in 2010 as the world's first gluten free pilsner. (Melle, Belgium) 5% ABV 330ml **(v) (gf)**

40 **Veltins Alkoholfrei** £3
The best alcohol-free beer we could find. (Meschede-Grevenstein, Germany) 0-5% ABV 330ml **(af)**
