PALE

- 1 **Ceilidh**, William Bros Brewery £4
Bottled lager to beat any of the big brands. Good bite, hop character and biscuit. (Alloa, UK) 4-7% ABV 330ml **(v)**
- 2 **Schiehallion**, Harviestoun Brewery £5-20
Crisp, cask-conditioned pilsner style lager from Scotland. Winner of countless awards. (Clackmannanshire, UK) 4-8% ABV 500ml
- 3 **Lagerbier Hell**, Augustiner Brewery £5
Munich's oldest brewery makes a helles with finesse. The lager has superb drinkability and a friendly dryness. (Munich, Germany) 5-2% ABV 500ml
- 4 **Little Creatures Pale Ale** £4
A modern day classic. Galaxy and cascade hops give it a great grapefruit bite. (Fremantle, Australia) 5-2% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 5 **Oakham Citra** £5
Exotic grapefruit and lychee aroma. First UK brewery to use the hop de jour in a fresh pale ale. (Peterborough, UK) 4-6% ABV 500ml
- 6 **Kernel Pale Ale** £5
The new-world hops used vary week by week but the results are always popular. (London, UK) 5-6% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**
- 7 **Kernel IPA** £5
Brewed in deepest Bermondsey on a tiny scale. The hops change, but always expect a fruit salad. (London, UK) 7-8% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 8 **Punk IPA**, BrewDog Brewery £4
It's in a can. Resinous but crisp. Tropical with a firm bitter finish. (Aberdeenshire, UK) 5-6% ABV 330ml **(v)**
- 9 **Hoxton Special IPA**, Brodie's Brewery £4-50
Pale, passion fruit and piney West Coast style IPA. A house favourite from our neighbours in Leyton. (London, UK) 6-6% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 10 **Ageless**, Red Willow Brewery £6
Sweet citrus, full bodied and silky IPA. An OTT aroma and resinous tropical flavours! (Macclesfield, UK) 7-2% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 11 **Bethnal Pale Ale**, Redchurch Brewery £5
A brewery and beer named after our street. Hops that taste like strawberry. (London, UK) 5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 12 **Saison Du Pont** £5
Harvest refreshment. Tart, crisp, dry, refreshing and known globally as *the saison*. (Wallonia, Belgium) 6-5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 13 **Wildeman IPA**, Flying Dog Brewery £6
Brewed for a great beer bar's 25th anniversary. Citra IPA fermented with Saison yeast. (Maryland, USA) 75 IBU 7-5% ABV 355ml **(v) (bc)**
- 14 **Tripel Karmeliet**, Bosteels Brewery £6
Lively, spicy Tripel originally made in 1679 by Carmelite monks. Oats, wheat and barley all feature. (Buggenhout, Belgium) 8% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 15 **White Ale**, Einstock Brewery £5
From the edge of the arctic circle. This witbier is deftly flavoured with orange peel and coriander. (Akureyri, Iceland) 5-2% ABV 330ml

AMBER, BROWN & RED

- 16 **Honkers Ale**, Goose Island Brewery £4
Best bitter with a bready malt flavour and gentle fruity hops; exceptionally easy drinking. (Chicago, USA) 30 IBU 4-2% ABV 355ml **(v) (bc)**
- 17 **Kwak**, Bosteels Brewery £5
The strong amber ale is notable for more than just its tricky test tube glass. Full bodied and alluring. (Buggenhout, Belgium) 8-9% ABV 330ml **(v)**
- 18 **Seven**, Bristol Beer Factory £4
Traditional best bitter. Toffee malt flavours, toast and caramel. Smooth hop bitterness and aroma. Classic. (Bristol, UK) 4-5% ABV 500ml **(v)**
- 19 **La Trappe Quadrupel** £7
A robust malty beast. Complicated aroma and taste; peach, dried fruits and a long rum-like finish. (Pilburg, Netherlands) 10% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 20 **Southville Hop**, Bristol Beer Factory £5
Grapefruit, pineapple, passion fruit and jaffa cakes from American hops. Great English/American IPA. (Bristol, UK) 6-5% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**
- 21 **Ripper**, Green Jack Brewery £12
Summer fruit, herb and toffee flavoured barley wine. A great sharing bottle. Peachy. (Lowestoft, UK) 8-5% ABV 750ml **(v) (bc) (s)**
- 22 **Orval** £5
It had to make a comeback. A sophisticated fermentation lends this Trappist beer great complexity and a long finish. (Gaume, Belgium) 6-2% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- BLACK**
- 23 **Cohort**, Summerwine Brewery £6
A double black Belgian rye IPA. Intensely fruity and resinous. Chinook, Columbus, Centennial and Simcoe hops make this a smack in the face kind of beer. (Yorkshire, UK) 7-5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 24 **Hercule Stout**, Ellezelloise Brewery £5-50
Named after Belgium's most famous detective, Hercule Poirot. Sprucey Belgian 'Imperial Stout'. (Ellezelles, Belgium) 8-4% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 25 **Bristol Milk Stout**, Bristol Beer Factory £4-50
Milk sugar in your stout is like cream in your coffee. Delicious sweet stout. (Bristol, UK) 4-5% ABV 500ml **(bc)**
- 26 **Kernel Export Stout: 1890 London** £5
'Supreme Champion' at the International Beer Challenge 2011. The Truman recipe is a house favourite all year round. (London, UK) 7-5% ABV 330ml **(v) (bc)**
- 27 **Nøgne Ø Porter**, Nøgne Ø Brewery £8
Rich yet mild. A porter with a soft, smooth mouthfeel from Norway's 'naked island'. (Grimstad, Norway) 30 IBU 7% ABV 500ml **(v) (bc)**
- 28 **Jacobite Ale**, Traquair Brewery £5
Brewed in the oldest inhabited house in Scotland. A coriander-spiced and oak-aged Scotch ale, made in memory of the 1745 Jacobite rebellion. (Peeblesshire, UK) 8% ABV 330ml **(v)**
- 29 **Hawse Buckler**, Oakham Brewery £5-50
Smells like chocolate raisins. Tastes like roasted coffee, sweet fruits and complex malts with a spicy bitter finish. (Peterborough, UK) 5-5% ABV 500ml

ODDITIES

- 30 **Innis & Gunn Rum Cask Oak-aged beer** £5
The pioneers of barrel-aged beers. Navy Rum accentuates the sweet malt and also gives a spicy red fruit character. (Edinburgh, UK) 7-4% ABV 330ml **(v)**
- 31 **Fraoch Heather Ale**, Williams Bros Brewery £5
No hops, just heather, tastes of honey and flowers. It may be the oldest beer style in the world. (Alloa, UK) 5% ABV 500ml
- 32 **Mariage Parfait Oude Geuze**, Boon Brewery £8
Traditional, chewy, appley sour beer. The pinnacle of Boon's lambic blending craft. (Lembeek, Belgium) 8% ABV 375ml **(v) (bc) (s)**
- 33 **Thirstly Cross Cider** £5
It's not beer. The medium-dry cider is sessionable, lightly sparkling and smooth. (East Lothian, UK) 7-2% ABV 500ml **(v)**
- 34 **Goose Island Root Beer** £2-75
Harking back to the 1920s when fermented soft drinks taught the beer industry how to force-carbonate 'beers'. Smells like tiger balm but tastes like a beaut. (Chicago, USA) 0% ABV 355ml **(v)**
- FRUIT**
- 35 **Kasteel Rouge** £5
'Cherry Tunes' without the menthol. Kasteel's lovely brown ale is matured for six months with sour cherries. (Ingelmunster, Belgium) 8% ABV 330ml
- 36 **Rosé de Gambrinus**, Cantillion Brewery £9-50
This raspberry lambic is lip puckering sour and bone dry. 70g of raspberries per bottle. A world classic. (Brussels, Belgium) 5% ABV 375ml **(v) (bc) (s)**
- 37 **Mongozo Coconut**, Huyghe Brewery £4-50
This fairtrade coconut beer is brewed from Quinoa - a traditional Incan grain often referred to as the 'mother grain'. It tastes like coconut. (Melle, Belgium) 3-5% ABV 330ml **(v)**
- 38 **Lindemans Cassis** £4
Belgians have used blackcurrants for centuries to make crisp, sweet/sour lambic fruit beers. (St Pieters Leeuw-Vlezenbeek, Belgium) 3-5% ABV 250ml **(v)**

- 39 **Mongozo Pilsner**, Huyghe Brewery £4
Light, bitter hoppy taste. Launched in 2010 as the world's first gluten free pilsner. (Melle, Belgium) 5% ABV 330ml **(v) (gf)**
- 40 **Veltins Alcohol Free** £3
This pilsner is the best alcohol-free beer we could find. Grassy, citrusy hop seasoning on a bready malt base. (Meschede-Grevenstein, Germany) 0-5% ABV 330ml **(af)**

- Hophead**, Dark Star Brewery £3-50
Our house ale and favourite session beer. Packed with biscuity malt and citrusy cascade hops. (West Sussex, UK) 3-8% ABV
- Camden Hells Lager** £4
Very clean drinking helles (Munich) style lager. Light and refreshing. (London, UK) 4-6% ABV **(v)**
- Meantime London Pale Ale** £4-50
Kentish Goldings hops give bitterness. US Cascade and Centennial hops give citrus aroma. Sessionable. (London, UK) 4-3% ABV
- Dark Arts 'Surreal Stout'**, Magic Rock Brewery £5
Move over Guinness. Brewed since 2011, the full-bodied stout is from Huddersfield's and one of Britain's finest. (Huddersfield, UK) 6% ABV
- Brooklyn Lager** £5
Viennese style lager containing caramel malt. With roots in prohibition-era New York; a modern day classic. (New York, USA) 5-2% ABV **(v)**
- Schneider Weisse Original** £5
The world's best wheat beer? Highly carbonated hefeweizen. Full bodied, spicy and rich. (Kelheim, Germany) 5-4% ABV **(v)**
